

ACSA NGR (Next Gen National Rider) - Position Description

1. Position Title: *ACSA NGR (Next Gen National Rider)*

2. Supervisor or Whom Person Reports: ACSA Board of Directors and ACSA Future Leaders Coordinator

3. Position Summary: Next Gen National Riders (NGNR) are here to support, promote, and grow potential future snowmobile community leadership along with the sport of snowmobiling for current and future generations.

4. Responsibilities: Primary key areas of responsibility (bullet Points)

- Next Gen National Riders (NGNR) will support and promote the sport of snowmobiling within their region. This shall be done by promoting Next Gen National Riders to get 21–30-year-olds together to help and support counties, clubs and communities in their regions with snowmobile related events, work days, rides, etc.
- Next Gen National Riders will be responsible for establishing a good form of communication amongst other Next Gen Riders, state and local snowmobile groups, and the American Council of Snowmobile Association via phone and email.
- Next Gen National Riders are also responsible to document, photograph and share what their region has been doing to support and grow the sport via the ACSA e-newsletter, ACSA webpage and social media.
- Next Gen National Riders should be willing to participate in the DC Fly-in, International Snowmobile Congress and regular ACSA full board meetings enabling NGR representatives to stay up to date on current education and information regarding snowmobiling.

5. Competencies:

- Positive attitude and outgoing personality
- Basic knowledge of the sport of snowmobiling and safety protocols
- Knowledge of computer software operation: MS Office, Zoom or Go To Webinar and various Social Media sites
- Ability to communicate verbally and written

6. Qualifications: minimum education required for job

- Must have a valid driver's license
- High School diploma, with experience in leadership programs is a plus.

7. Summary of work conditions: The ACSA Future Leaders / Next Gen National Riders program is a leadership development program focusing on snowmobilers between the ages of 21-30 years of age. They need to have a desire to enhance their personal leadership skills while simultaneously

growing the sport of snowmobiling through hands on participation in the program. NGNR participants will participate in and represent one of two regions in the sport of snowmobiling: either the Trails Region or Mountain Region. Reliable Internet access with the ability to access internet meeting software, email, along with access to social media. NGNR participants will be asked to attend the DC Fly-in, ISC (International Snowmobile Congress), and regular ACSA full board meetings enabling NGNR representatives to stay up to date on current education and information regarding snowmobiling. A personal laptop or iPad to help with participation within the program is also recommended.

8. Compensation: Travel and per diem reimbursement to attend required events as applicable funds may available.
